

Rural funding

The Princes Countryside Funds has opened up its grant funding, and rural communities have the opportunity to apply for up to £50,000 of funding towards projects affecting areas of greatest need in England, Wales, Scotland and Northern Ireland. Applications for funding must show how they clearly contribute towards one or more of The Prince's Countryside Fund's objectives:

- To sustain rural communities and drive economic vibrancy.
- To improve the prospects of viability for family farm businesses.
- To support aid delivery in emergency and building resilience.

The funding should have a long-term positive impact on rural communities, helping those that live and work there to sustain the countryside, by tackling key rural issues.
