Church of St Laurence

Is an ancient church in Wichenford. The Church looks to uphold traditional values whilst appreciating that services need to change to accommodate new styles of worship.

The incumbent is the local Rural Dean, the Rev. Canon David Sherwin.

Defibrillators

There is one public defibrillator in the village, which can be accessed in the green telephone box in the centre of the village.

Doctors

The parish is served by two doctors' surgeries, one at [Knightwick Surgery](#), which also holds limited surgeries on Mon and Fri in the Memorial Hall in Martley and [Great Witley Surgery](#), which holds surgeries daily at Great Witley and on certain weekdays in Martley.

Due to current restrictions please check details for appointments on the websites.

Malvern and Tenbury hospitals operate a weekday minor injuries unit and full accident and emergency facilities are available at Worcester Royal and Hereford County Hospital.

Footpaths

The village boasts a large network for footpaths, green lanes and some bridlepaths. Two foot path officers Liz Stansfeld and Jane Eve.
